

Sum What Dice Game

1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
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Materials:

2 dice (1-6)

Playing strip (1-9)

Beans or other markers

Paper and pencil

Game:

Give a playing strip to each player (or write the numbers 1 through 9 on paper).

Players take turns rolling two dice. On each turn, the player may cover either the sum rolled on the two dice or any two numbers still uncovered that add to that sum. For example: If a sum of 9 is rolled, the player may cover 9, or 1 and 8, or 2 and 7, or 3 and 6, or 4 and 5. Later in the game if the player rolls a 9 and the 5 is already covered, the player must find a combination other than 4 and 5 to cover. When a player cannot play, he or she is out and has a score of the sum of any uncovered numbers. Play until everyone is out. The person with the lowest score wins.
